The **KME WADER** is a stocking foot wader made from the best quality American materials for cold water wading and Float Tube fishing. Boot Footed Waders are available as an Optional add on. The **KME WADER** is made from the finest grade closed cell neoprene sheet sponge with nylon jersey bonded to both sides (the same grade that quality diving drysuits are made from) for warmth, lightness, stretchability (for freedom of movement and better fit), rugged wear and easy entry.

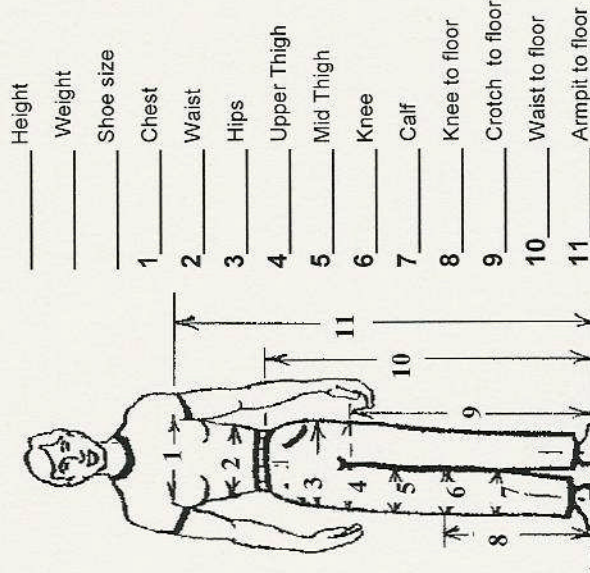
The most popular **KME WADER** is the chest high style, with optional high front, high back or both. The seams are bonded with three coats of space age adhesive, blind stitched (the needle doesn't pass through the neoprene, only sews the nylon layer) on the outside with nylon thread, then are sealed inside by a special process. The result is seams that **KME** guarantees against separating or leaking (see warranty).

The **KME WADER** comes with an outside chest pocket with a Velcro fastened cover flap to keep out rain and debris and to keep "whatever" in. The stocking foot is constructed with no seams under your feet to cause discomfort or rapid wear. Permanent adjustable suspenders are featured, with quick release buckles in the front. You can order your **KME WADER** with many Options, including gravel guards and coated feet (see OPTION section). Color choices are BROWN (stock color), Black, Grey, Blue, or Camouflage (extra cost for Camo).

MEASURING INSTRUCTIONS

You cannot measure yourself accurately, so enlist someone to assist. Wear the type clothing you will normally be wearing under the wader. Stand in your stocking feet, with feet slightly apart (3" to 4") and stand upright, look straight ahead. Using the diagram as a guide, begin measuring and entering the measurements on the appropriate line with the corresponding number to the measurement position on the diagram as follows:

- Place tape around chest with arms raised, drop arms then measure at largest part, (usually just under armpit).
- Measure around waist at largest part, (about navel level).
- Measure around hips at largest part, (usually just above crotch level, around buttocks).
- Measure around thigh just below crotch.
- Measure to a point 1/2 way between the crotch and the knee. At that point, measure around the thigh and enter that measurement on chart.
- Measure around the center of the knee.
- Measure around calf at largest part, (usually about five inches below the knee).
- Measure from the center of the knee to the floor, inside leg is best.
- Hold end of tape in crotch center (where seams cross on most pants) at the height desired for the crotch of the wader and measure the distance along the seam on the inside of the leg to the floor.
- For Waist High Waders, measure from the top height you wish, to the floor on the outside of the leg.
- Standing straight, have subject hold end of tape under one arm at armpit (the desired top of wader), then measure to floor on the outside of the leg.

If you are ordering a **stock Wader**, follow across the page to the number of your measurements at the left to the number on the chart below until your measurements all fall into a size category on the chart (not all measurements are listed on the stock size chart).

USE AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Use care donning and doffing wader.
- After each use rinse off wader with fresh water. If wader comes in contact with petroleum product, wash in front load tumble type washer with mild detergent. Fasten suspender buckles before washing.
- Hang wader by suspenders to dry, if wet inside turn wader inside out carefully and dry inside first.
- Store wader away from sunlight in a dry area and away from any paint or petroleum products or fumes. Hang by suspenders over WIDE hanger or peg, or on the closet hanger bar.

With proper care your **KME WADER** should give you many seasons of DRY fishing pleasure.

WARRANTY

The seams of your **KME WADER** are warranted to be free of leaks for **ONE YEAR**. Further, your **KME WADER** is warranted against any defects in the materials or the workmanship for the serviceable life of the WADER.
